ELIGIBILITY: Open to any USBC Youth member and any USBC Adult member. The youth must bowl in Oklahoma. You may buy your membership on site if your current league is not certified.

<u>DIVISIONS:</u> There will be four divisions, based on combined team average. Handicap is 80% of 420.

- 1. Scratch Division (all one division, no split)
- 2. Handicap: combined team average of 340 and above
- 3. Handicap: combined team average of 339 to 260
- 4. Handicap: combined team average of 259 and below

Average: 2022-2023 Composite Book Average. If no book average, use highest average of 15 games. If you do not have 15 games, you will be a scratch bowler. You may use a sport average if there is no other available average. Sport averages will be converted based on the USBC conversation chart. If you have no average, you will bowl on a 210.

ENTRY FEES: \$25.00 per person / \$50.00 per team, cash or check. Checks are to be made out to Oklahoma Bowling Council. Breakdown per team is \$16 towards SMART and \$34 lineage/awards/expenses. Scholarships will be awarded at a 1:6 ratio per division. Bowlers can earn SMART money more than once as long as it is with different partners, adults do not earn cash prizes.

- Re-entry \$50.00 per team.
- Sharing scores, across divisions, in the same squad is \$16.00 per team.
- Sharing scores with bowlers in your same squad is \$16.00 per team.

FORMAT: Tournament will be a doubles format, with each bowler bowling three (3) games. This is a handicap and scratch tournament. Handicap is based on team average, and the handicap percentage is 80% of 420. Re-entry is allowed, and you may share scores with other bowlers in your squad, you CANNOT share scores outside of your squad. If you wish to bowl in the handicap and scratch division, in the same squad, your team must pay a \$16.00 entry fee to bowl both divisions at the same time.

DRESS CODE: Dress code is casual, no athletic shorts, no jeans with holes, t-shirts or jerseys allowed, but must be appropriate (no sexual content, no depictions of drugs or alcohol). Tournament dress is always allowed. Female's shorts must be an appropriate length, fingertip length.

All bowlers must have current USBC Membership (can be purchased on site) **USBC** rules apply
