## **RULES AND INFORMATION**

1. To be eligible to bowl in the Oklahoma State Queens Tournament entrant must be a current member of USBC and Oklahoma State USBC. Youth members may bowl with signed waiver of prize money to be added to their SMART account.
2. Entry Closing Date -- Midnight, October 14th or when 160 entries have been received.
3. 80% Handicap of Entrant's Average from 210. Any entrant with 150 average or under handicap will be figured from 150 average.
4. Entrants average will be figured using the following and in this order: 2022-2023 Composite Average, 2021-2022 Composite Average, if no average from the following two seasons a current average will be used of 21 or more games. All others will bowl scratch. Tournament management reserves the right to rerate bowlers according to USBC rules. Entrants may be required to provide average verification.
5. Rule 319a3 (average verification) does apply. Failure to report the correct average will result in disqualification or base prize winnings on submitted average if it is higher. Rule 319a (ten pin rule), Rule 319d (prize winnings) and Rule 319e (tournament games) do not apply.
6. Entry Fee: \$100 cash only on the day of the tournament. Break down is \$21.00 lineage, \$74.00 prize fund, \$5.00 award fee.
7. Prize Fund will be returned 100%. The top 16 who qualify for match play will earn prize money.
8. Entries will be made online at [bowloklahoma.org](http://bowloklahoma.org). Entry fee will be paid the day of the tournament and it will be cash only.
9. Bowling will start at 10:00 am. Check-in will begin at 9:15 am.
10. Lane Assignments and Rotation – Lane assignments will be assigned by the tournament manager and bowlers will move a pair after each game. Lane assignments for match play will be posted before match play begins.
11. Tie rules - if a tie for 16th occurs, there will be a 9th and 10th frame roll-off. Ties in the top 16 will be broken by highest game in qualifying. Match game tie breaker - bowl 10th frame roll-off plus 1/10th single game handicap.
12. USBC rules will be followed and used for this tournament.
